Assessment Days for Semester 1 are scheduled to take place from Friday, January 24, 2025 to Thursday, January 30, 2025. Each of your student's courses, regardless of grade should have a final evaluation/culminating task scheduled during this time. Assessment Days will have a different schedule than our regular days. Students are expected to attend each assessment and to remain in the assessment location for a minimum of one hour. Upon completion of the evaluation/assessment task, students are no longer required to remain at school and are welcome to return home. Any students requiring a quiet, supervised study space after their morning assessment, must report to the Library Learning Commons.

ASSESSMENT LOCATIONS

Unless otherwise notified, students will complete their Assessment, Examination or Culminating Task in their regular classroom. If any students are writing in a different location, this will be shared with the student by one's teacher.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Please note that Thursday, January 30 is the inclement weather day and will only be used if needed. In the event of inclement weather where transportation is cancelled for the school or if the school is closed, the schedule will move forward by one day. For example, if there is a school closure or a cancellation of transportation on Friday, January 24, these assessments/evaluations will be moved to Monday, January 27 or a cancellation on Tuesday, January 28 will see the assessment/evaluation moved to Wednesday, January 29, etc.

TRANSPORTATION

If your child usually takes a school bus, please note that the school bus schedule will remain the same as during all regular school days. If a student needs transportation and wants to leave earlier, they will have to find their own mode of transportation home.

ATTENDANCE

Families are asked to avoid scheduling appointments and vacations during Final Assessment/Evaluation Days from January 24 to February 1 inclusive. We ask that families keep all these dates available for students to complete evaluation tasks, as it is sometimes necessary to change assessment/evaluation schedules within this time frame if there is inclement weather. Students are expected to be in attendance for their assessment/evaluation tasks on the designated Assessment/Evaluation days at the end of the semester.

In the event of student illness, a parent/guardian must contact the school directly prior to 9:05AM on the Assessment/Evaluation Day. A voicemail and/or email can also be sent to the school right up to the start time of the evaluation task, if an illness emerges at the last minute. If a student is absent January 24 – January 31 for non-approved reasons other than illness, a mark of zero may result for missed evaluation tasks. Students enrolled in Development Education classes will attend each of the designated Assessment/Evaluation days as per their usual timetable.

Students in Developmental Education classes will attend each of the designated Assessment/Evaluation days as per their usual timetable.
