

Eligible Credit Requirements



Credits that count towards the online learning graduation requirement include:

- One credit only earned during the period of school closure April-June 2021*
- Credits earned through summer school virtual learning (asynchronous)
- Credits earned through TVDVA (Thames Valley District Virtual Academy) e-Learning

**Due to the extraordinary circumstances of the pandemic, the ministry will recognize up to one secondary school credit completed by grade 9 students in the 2020-21 school year during the province-wide school closures from April 2021-June 2021.*

Credits that are NOT Eligible



Credits that DO NOT count towards the online learning graduation requirement include:

- Credits earned during **full remote learning** in 2021-2022 and 2022-2023.
- Credits earned through a **blended model**, in which digital resources are used in an in-person environment or students are taught part of the time in person and part of the time online.

Opt Out Process



Parents or caregivers will have the option to opt their child out of this online learning graduation requirement. As students do not need to officially opt out until just prior to Secondary school graduation, more information will be communicated at a later date.
